**CLINIC INFORMATION:**

**Instructor:** Lynnette Milleville. Lynnette has taught herding all over the world and is one of the original authors of the AKC herding program. She did all past PON clinics for us, which were fabulous!

**Time:** Start is at 9am until 4pm. Each dog goes into the ring once in the morning and once in the afternoon.

**Number of Participants:** We need a minimum of 10 PONs, the maximum is 25.

**Cost:** The cost is \$45 per dog.

## ***Directions to Nutmeg Farm***

### **From Hartford**

Rt 84 East exit 55 to Rt 2 East  
Rt 2 to Rt 17 South (Glastonbury-Portland)  
Left at Isinglass Hill Road for .7 miles.  
Turn right on to Thompson Hill Road for 1.4 miles.  
Turn left at Old Marlborough Turnpike .4 miles.  
Turn right on South Road for .6 miles.  
Farm on Right.

### **From South (Middletown) RT 17/Rt 66**

Follow over Connecticut River into Portland.  
Turn right on to Rt 66 (East) follow for 2 miles.  
Turn left onto Rt 17 (North) follow for 2 miles  
Turn right on to Sage Hollow Road for .3 miles.  
Take slight right on to Rose Hill road for .2 miles  
Turn left on to Cox Road 1.2 miles  
Turn left on to South Road .3 miles  
Farm on left.
